

The Aurora, Giltner and High Plains boys basketball teams finished their seasons rated in the top 10 of their respective classes, as announced earlier this week.

The Huskies finished the year No. 9 in Class B, according to the Lincoln Journal Star. Ratings include South Sioux City (16-12), Scottsbluff (23-6), Gretna (19-8), Elkhorn South (19-7), Ralston (19-7), Waverly (18-8), Omaha Gross (14-9), York (19-6), Aurora (14-10) and Norris (15-6).

High Plains and Giltner both finished the season rated No. 5 in D1 and D2, respectively, in the Journal Star.

D1 ratings include Howells-Dodge (29-0), Paxton (27-1), St. Mary's (24-3), Burwell (25-4), High Plains (21-5), Kenesaw (23-2), Arapahoe (24-5), Johnson-Brock (12-15), BDS (21-4) and Guardian Angels CC (11-14).
